Early this year we embarked on a new journey to increase our stallion power and we were lucky enough to enter into a joint venture with Aquis Farm of Australia to stand both Divine Prophet and Santos at the farm alongside resident sire Wrote.

Divine Prophet is of course a full brother to Proisir whose transition over the past two years has been nothing short of phenomenal. Divine Prophet has made a very promising start to his stud career siring five stakes horses already in Australia, including two G2 winners. Aquis have decided to relocate a number of their stallions where they feel they can best succeed in the future and it is very clear through the deeds of Proisir the bloodline is particularly suited to the NZ broodmare population.

Santos is very interesting being the only son of Champion Australian sire I Am Invincible available in NZ. Of course since his arrival at the farm he has become the sire of a G1 winner in Ulanova and has left a number of impressive 2YO winners in Australia. He has some exciting prospects for the forthcoming racing season.

Wrote continues to go from strength to strength. This season, Best Seller, a G3 winner of the Gold Trail Stakes followed up by a gallant second to Legarto in the G1 1000 Guineas, while in Australia Wrote To Arataki was also successful at G3 level, no mean feat given numbers of runners. We are predicting an interesting season for him in 2023/24.

Finally, I would like to extend an invitation to you to visit the farm and inspect these exciting sire prospects and we will do our best to accommodate you in your quest to breed your next top class runner.

Entain's involvement with the TAB and the rising stakes on offer for the future certainly gives one more confidence for our industry going forward than it has for a very long time.

- G1 WINNING FULL BROTHER TO PROISIR -

A son of the highly successful and emerging sire of sires Choisir, Divine Prophet scored a career defining victory in the G1 MRC Caulfield Guineas (1600m), won in the past by Champion Stallions Vain, Lonhro and Redoute's Choice.

Posting a scintillating last to first victory in the G3 ATC Up And Coming Stakes (1300m), a race previously won by Marscay, Snitzel, Fastnet Rock and Exceed And Excel – all of whom have gone on to become Champion Sires in Australia, Divine Prophet is a full-brother to the G3 winning, G1 placed Proisir, now a G1 stallion.

One of only four G1 winning sons of his sire standing at stud in Australiasia, Divine Prophet is out of the blue hen mare Prophet Jewel, a daughter of the twice crowned Champion Broodmare Sire Encosta de Lago.

With his oldest runners now 4YOs, Divine Prophet has already produced over 77 individual winners including Group-winning 2YO PROMITTO (ATC Skyline S. G2) and G2 Sandown Guineas winner SEE YOU IN HEAVEN, along with stakes placed horses Soothsayer, Fortunate Kiss and Kamitori.

- OFF TO A GREAT START WITH G1 WINNER ULANOVA -

The only son of breed shaper and emerging sire of sires I Am Invincible in NZ, an all-time Australian record holder for the amount of SW in a season (27). The good-looking Santos was a fast and precocious juvenile trained by the all-conquering Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott stable.

Santos is off to a great start at stud with G1 winner ULANOVA.

A winner at the early Spring 2YO trials, Santos made his debut with a solid third in the Listed ATC Breeders Plate.

Commencing his autumn campaign with an easy victory in the \$150,000 ATC Pierro Plate (1100m) at Randwick, he then booked his place in the G1 ATC Golden Slipper (1200m) with a tenacious win in the G2 ATC Skyline Stakes (1200m), a race which historically attracts a high-class field of colts and has been a great stallion-making race, won in the

past by Snitzel, Choisir, Hinchinbrook and Manhattan Rain.

Bred by Emirates Park, Santos comes from one of their most successful families being a half-brother to Japanese G3 winner Melagrana from a half-sister to Group winners Mutawaajid, Adeewin and Fatoon, the dam of G1 ATC Epsom Handicap (1600m) winner Fat Al.

Completely free of Danehill blood, Santos has the good looks, natural speed and quality that are the hallmarks of his famous sire I Am Invincible.

His first crop of yearlings sold up to \$150,000!

Wrote is from the world famous stallion family of Sadler's Wells, Nureyev and Fairy King.

A phenomenal type, he was rated A+ on conformation by well-known Kentucky-based Bloodstock consultant Cecil Seaman, an expert in bio-mechanics. Less than 0.5% of all horses measured by Seaman fit into the A+ category which includes Secretariat, Seattle Slew, Affirmed and American Pharoah.
